

Hospitality Rider – Jackson Truluck

1. Room Temperature, bottled spring water made available during set up, throughout show, and during breakdown.
2. For venues in excess of 75 miles from Anderson, SC Lodging for five (5) band members and one (1) manager (2 rooms with 2 queen beds, 1 room with 1 queen or King bed). A condo with suitable sleeping arrangements for six (6) people is acceptable as well.
3. One (1) Size 3x venue t-shirt (Size 2X is acceptable if no 3x in stock)
4. Access to a room for wardrobe change prior to show
5. One hot meal for all band members (i.e., pizza, burgers, hotdogs, chicken strips, chicken wings, BBQ) or meal tickets for on site vendors. If no food is to be provided, buy out of approximately \$15 per band member/manager is applicable.
6. Snacks such as chips (Lays or Pringles) or tortilla chips and mild queso dip or spinach dip.
7. All visible marketing or promotional items (i.e., social media posts, flyers, videos) MUST have appropriate spelling, grammar and punctuation.
8. Raw Honey, tea and hot water (simple plain, quality tea bags are fine)
9. 2 Boxes of Puffs Plus tissue (any Kleenex with lotion is acceptable)
- 10.1 roll of absorbent paper towels (not brand specific)
11. Merchandise area that is well lit, in plain view of every person entering and exiting the venue
12. If drums are to be set up on a drum riser, steps to access the riser without risk of bodily injury are required.
13. If stage is elevated more than 8 inches, a hand railing or additional step is required.
14. Access to load in and sound check at least 2.5 hours prior to the start of show.
